



Parking Permit Guide for Residents and Employees Village of Lake Placid 2026-2027

This guide provides an overview of the parking permit programs available to residents, employees, contractors and special events that may have the opportunity to utilize parking spaces within the Village of Lake Placid including Main Street. Its purpose is to clearly outline the types of permits offered, eligibility requirements, application procedures, and associated regulations. By consolidating this information in one place, the municipality aims to improve transparency, ensure consistent administration, and help users better understand their parking options and responsibilities.

The Village of Lake Placid **does not issue** any type of all-day parking permits for any spaces located directly on Main Street between 2403 Main Street (Brewster Park) and 2693 Main Street (Town Hall), known as the Main Street Core.

All parking located within the Main Street Core is **metered and time-limited**.

The following permits are available:

- **Annual Parking Permits** -These permits allow parking in **designated permit-only areas**. Permit-only parking areas are clearly marked. A parking meter receipt or mobile app payment does **not** authorize parking in permit-only spaces. (Obtain from the Lake Placid Village Police office).
 - a. **Non-Transferable Parking Permit** – available to residents and employees of the Main Street Core (see application for regulations).
 - b. **Transferable Parking Permit** – available to Short-Term Rental properties and businesses of the Main Street core (see application for regulations).
- **Resident Parking Sticker** - available to Village of Lake Placid and Town of North Elba residents who are property owners or registered voters. This pass allows free parking during the hours of 8am-11am and 6pm-8pm.
- **Temporary Parking Permit** - The Temporary Parking Permit is issued to contractors, subcontractors, and service providers engaged in active construction or maintenance projects. It provides temporary authorization to park in designated areas while work is being performed and is valid only for the approved project duration and under established municipal regulations.
- **Special Event Permit** - The Special Event Parking Permit is intended for organizers of municipally approved events that generate increased parking demand. It provides temporary authorization for parking in designated locations and may include specific conditions related to timing, capacity, and traffic management.

Applications for the Annual Parking Permit can be obtained on-line and submitted in person at the Lake Placid Police Department

Applications for the Resident Parking Sticker can be obtained in person at the Village Clerk's Office.
